The Graduate Certificate in Mental Health and Addictions is evidence-based, interprofessional and reflective of diverse populations, with an emphasis on applied learning. COURSES

The Graduate Certificate in Mental Health and Addictions consists of four courses which are current and person centred:

- Mental Health and Addictions Services and Systems
- Mental Health, Substance Use and Addiction across Health Practices
- Concurrent Disorders and Complex Case Work
- Prevention, Early Intervention and Population-Focussed Health Promotion

Course content addresses knowledge and skill gaps identified by a wide range of stakeholders, including front-line staff and senior leadership with the Nova Scotia Health Authority and the provincial government. Students will gain new skills, confidence and knowledge of best practices. Graduates will also be better prepared to improve policies, practices and programs in mental health and addictions.
